Module Aims

This module aims to provide students with the opportunity to:

- Make recommendations for improving a service by undertaking a project in an area relevant to their practice through critical review of the literature and critical analysis of service data.

Outline Syllabus

Research and service improvement topics will include; conducting a literature review, developing a research question, aims and objectives, planning a project, the difference between research, service evaluation and quality improvement, quantitative and qualitative methodologies, including analysis, critical evaluation of data and results, structuring a project write-up, placing findings within the context of the literature, critical and academic writing skills. In addition to generic reading material students will be directed by their supervisors to specific resources and literature that are relevant to their chosen project area.

04	Create a written report that presents data and makes recommendations in a style appropriate to the audience.			

Learning, Teaching and Assessment Strategy

Lectures will be used to give students the underpinning theory relating to undertaking a service improvement project and undertaking a literature review. These will be given by active researchers either at the University or out in practice, so that examples given are authentic and meaningful to students. Students will be allocated to a supervisor who will guide them through the process of designing and undertaking a project though one-to-one tutorials (content will be appropriate for the chosen project title). The supervisor will also provide individualised and tailored support throughout the project to ensure students understand the requirements of the assessment.

Students will have the opportunity to submit a formative draft of their project report for feedback from their supervisor, before submitting the final report, which is an 8,000 word write-up of the project. This assessment will meet learning outcomes 1-4.
